## Carriage

Carriages and Carriage Parts - Rated by the tine carriage hoisting capacity, there are four sizings of hook type fork carriages. The hook type tine carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class I is 13 inches. Class II carriages are rated for cargo as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

Pin mounted forks differ by the amount of offset between the fork and the tine eye. Different makers would differ the carriages for pin type forks. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
