

Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriage - There are 4 sizings of hook type tine carriages rated by the blade carriage lifting capability. Hook type tine carriages have been uniform.

The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class 1 is approximately thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry loads as much as 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to hold cargo up to 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type forks can be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted forks may vary by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the blade. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
